### HOW DID YOU ORGANIZE THE DIALOGUE SO THAT THE PRINCIPLES WERE INCORPORATED, REINFORCED AND ENHANCED?

The Dialogue was explicitly organized to support coordination and complementarity across the two key summits of the 2021 UN General Assembly: Food Systems Summit and the High-Level Dialogue on Energy. All participants were asked to identify deliverables that had triple food, energy, and climate benefits and that could be promoted in both summits, in addition to COP26. The event was also promoted across the stakeholder groups for both summits to facilitate awareness and ownership of the summits' nexus.

### HOW DID YOUR DIALOGUE REFLECT SPECIFIC ASPECTS OF THE PRINCIPLES?

In addition to its integration of content for the food systems and energy summit preparatory processes, the 36 speakers reflected geographic, gender, entity, and age diversity. Participants were also able to submit proposals for the outcome document directly to the organizers.
