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OUTCOMES FOR EACH DISCUSSION TOPIC

The key findings/recommendations from this dialogue include:

- i. There is a need to address key bottlenecks in Uganda's food systems as identified in the regional and independent dialogues.
- ii. Low quality inputs, poor farming practices, limited markets, poor transportation and logistics, and land fragmentation have been identified as important bottlenecks in Uganda's food systems
- iii. There is an invitation to development partners to work with Uganda to address bottlenecks affecting food systems.
- iv. There is renewed emphasis on how to capitalize on the good climatic conditions of Uganda to make Uganda a perfect food basket for the region
