4. DIALOGUE FOCUS & OUTCOMES

MAJOR FOCUS

In this dialogue, four relevant ministries gathered to discuss how to implement the Korea's National Food Plans developed by the Presidential Committee and relevant ministries this February. The plan had been discussed since July 2019 and aimed to secure sustainability of agriculture and fisheries through harmonizing economy, society and environment.

MAIN FINDINGS

Participants rechecked the details of the National Food Plan and agreed that cooperation among the relevant ministries was essential to address the issues such as food & nutritional education and food waste, in particular. It was acknowledged that continuous consultation between ministries was an achievement in itself on matters of disagreement between ministries or unconfirmed sources of finance.

MAFRA said it would develop MAFRA's National Food Plan which contains implementation of the existing National Food Plan, and requested the cooperation of other ministries in the process.

In addition, related ministries agreed to participate in the next National Dialogues hosted by MAFRA and KREI.
